The North Carolina Association of Electric Cooperatives Volunteer's Committee established the Gwyn B. Price Youth Tour Scholarship (1981) and Katie Bunch Memorial Scholarship (1989) to contribute to the development of future leaders. Today, the North Carolina Association of Electric Cooperatives supports and coordinates the scholarship programs along with participating co-op volunteers. The scholarships are awarded annually to eligible college-bound students who have demonstrated outstanding scholastic and leadership abilities.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for these competitive scholarships you must:

Be a current year NCAEC Youth Tour participant

Be a college-bound high school student

Demonstrate strong academic and leadership skills

Meet the application deadline

AWARDS

Scholarship awards are determined by the Scholarship Committee.

All applicants are notified of their application status following the decision.

Presentation of Awards is made during the NCEMC/NCAEC/TEMA Annual Meeting in Raleigh.

PAYMENT

Upon receipt of enrollment confirmation, scholarship money is paid directly to the college or university according to the institution's payment policy.

CONDITIONS

In the event the recipient receives financial assistance from other sources which constitute a full scholarship, he/she must relinquish rights to the scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded to the qualifying runner-up.
